



## Three methods to hook up gaming systems:

1) Check to see if your television has RCA outputs on the back (red and white plugs). The most common RCA connections are inputs and these will not work, so it must say output by it. Not all televisions have RCA outputs. If you do, then you can use the B1 wire to connect the chair directly to the TV. The green part goes in the input of the chair control panel. The red and white plugs connect directly to the RCA output.

2) If your game system connects to your television via RCA connections (red, white, and yellow). Simply unplug the red and white wires from the back of the television. The yellow cord should remain connected to your television. Attach the red and white wires that you unplugged to the B3 adaptors (Female to Female, single tube connectors). On the other end of these adaptors connect the B1 wire that connects to the chair input. Only the yellow wire, from the gaming system should be plugged into the television.

3) If you have a PS3 gaming system with an HDMI cable, you will use your HDMI cable for your video only. Please acquire the standard RCA cable, and plug it into your PS3, alongside your HDMI cable. (They plug in side by side) Follow the set up above for connecting the cables together (you can let the yellow RCA cable lay off to the side, being sure that it does not touch anything metal). Then you will need to go into the PS3 menu screen. Go into your sound settings, and you will select the third selection, which is labeled "Audio Input Connector/ SCART / AV MULTI. This will let the PS3 know to send the audio through the RCA cables. Load a game into the PS3, make sure everything is turned on and the volume is turned up, and enjoy!
